

All new general education high school students will be required to request their SMART-Tag Bus Pass for the 2023-2024 school year beginning July 17, 2023. All returning general education high school students will receive an email notification with instructions to respond with their student's ridership verification status for the school year. Returning students must complete the new process for their existing pass to renew. If you do not receive the email notification by June 16, 2023, please contact our office to update your email address with our Administrative Assistant, Sherynn Morton.

NEW general education Lancaster and Westside Union School District students must complete the Transit Bus Transportation Request (TBTR) form for the 2023-2024 school year. The form can be obtained from the school secretary and the student must return it to the school within 5 business days to avoid loss of ridership. Students will receive their SMART-Tag pass from their bus driver. For returning students, if you have moved, please update the TBTR to confirm ridership eligibility. For returning students who have not moved, your Smart-Tag pass will automatically renew, no further action is required.

Special needs students must complete the BSR process for the 2023-2024 school year, upon placement on a route students will receive their initial SMART-Tag from their bus driver when the new school year begins.

For returning students who have lost their pass, a replacement pass must be requested online. After the request for the replacement has been processed, students will receive the pass from the driver when school returns. PLEASE NOTE, GENERAL EDUCATION HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MUST PAY FOR AND PICK UP THEIR REPLACEMENT PASS IN PERSON AT AVSTA 670 W. AVE L - 8, LANCASTER CA, 93534
